
West End project





WHAT IS THE WEST END PROJECT?



The West End Project is Camden Council's £35 million scheme to deliver exciting improvements to the heart of Camden's busy West End. Work is now underway to transform the areas around Tottenham Court Road, Gower Street, Bloomsbury Street, Princes Circus and St Giles, helping the area to continue to grow and flourish.

GOWER STREET / BLOOMSBURY STREET

- Free from buses as all routes are moved to Tottenham Court Road
- Protected cycle lanes in both directions

GREEN SPACES



PRINCES CIRCUS

Princes Circus has been beautifully redesigned to improve the pedestrian route between Covent Garden and the British Museum. The historic drinking fountain will be restored and relocated and the plinth will be covered over by a decked seating area.

New pedestrian crossings will make the area easier and safer for people to navigate while access to West Central Street and Grape Street will be maintained.

ALFRED PLACE




WEP FREIGHT STRATEGY

LOADING HOURS



Tottenham Court Rd Restricted Areas

Loading only bays in the restricted areas will only be accessible outside these hours (8am-7pm Mon-Sat).

Tottenham Court Rd Unrestricted Areas

Loading only bays. Those bays in the unrestricted zone will be accessible for loading during the restricted hours (8am-7pm Mon-Sat).




Gower/Bloomsbury St

Loading is restricted due to the presence of a stepped cycle lane. Outside peak hours loading applies (i.e. 10am-2pm Mon-Sun).

Side Streets

Loading is as per CPZ hours (Mon-Sat 8:30am-6:30pm) unless otherwise stated.

LOADING STRATEGY VISUALISED



Gower Street: **Restricted loading** due to stepped cycle track. 10am -2pm Mon-Sun

Single yellow lines available for loading

Side Street Loading: CPZ hours (8:30am-6:30pm Mon-Sat)

Tottenham Court Rd: Restricted area. Loading only bays but inaccessible (Mon-Sat 8am-7pm Mon-Sat

Tottenham Court Rd: Accessible area. Loading only bays.
