- Airports; Ports; Rail freight interchanges; Warehousing






Long-term objectives for the freight sector


E	Cost efficient	Supporting the sector to deliver globally competitive costs and support the broader UK economy with access to low-cost good tranport.

0	Resilient	Bolstering the freight network's capacity to anticipate absorb, resist or avoid disruption and recover when disruption does occur. Maintaining the smooth flow of goods thorughout.
S	Environmentally sustainable	Achieving a net zero freight and logistics sector by 2050, whilst supporting broader environmental objectives of air quality and noise reduction.
ŵ	Valued by society	Ensuring freight is valued by the public and decision makers across sectors reflecting its critical importance to the wider economy, and the lives of everyone in the UK.


